

To piece this block, follow these three steps, and refer to the finished and placement diagrams. This block is made of two triangle units, one light and one dark.

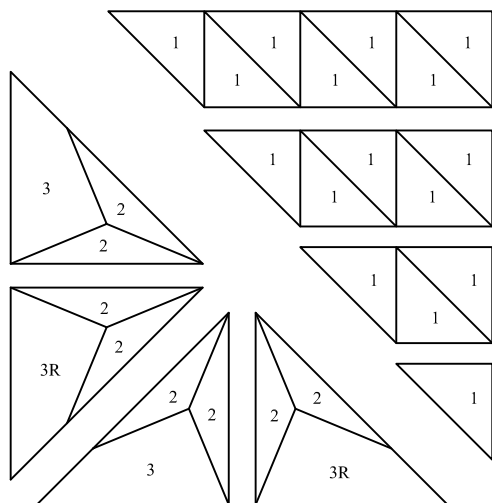
The dark side goes together easily using a sewing machine. The light side goes together better using hand piecing.

1. Construct the large dark triangle using the #1 pieces and sewing four rows.

Then sew the four rows together to form the triangle.

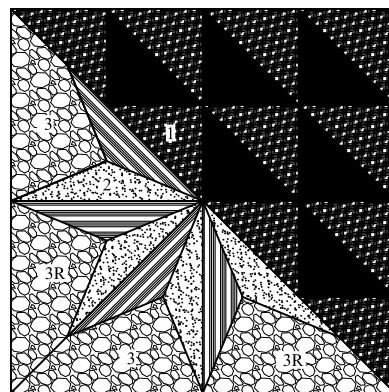
2. Construct the large light triangle by making two triangular units of pieces #2 and #3, and two triangular units of pieces #2 and #3R. Sew these four units together. The point where all of the #2 pieces come together will be bulky. Press all seam allowances one direction to minimize bulk.

3. Sew the two large triangles together to form a 12" (finished) or a 12 1/2" (unfinished) square. Multiples of this unit look nice in many of the traditional Log Cabin settings.
